**Deborah Spence** operates a dressage training facility in Onalaska, Washington. She has trained and competed in dressage Training level through Grand Prix and evented through Preliminary. She holds a USEF “R” Dressage Judge’s license and has earned her USDF Silver medal. Deborah believes that dressage is a sport requiring dedication and commitment to master but for many riders is also recreation and therefore instruction must be tailored for the rider/horse. Dressage can help the goal oriented competition rider and the rider who just wants the horse to better understand what is being asked of it. Early training of the horse is to help the horse learn how to learn. Early training of the rider should be to develop a balanced seat with coordinated aids so the rider can explore with confidence a full range of activities with the horse, be it trail riding, jumping, dressage or western.
